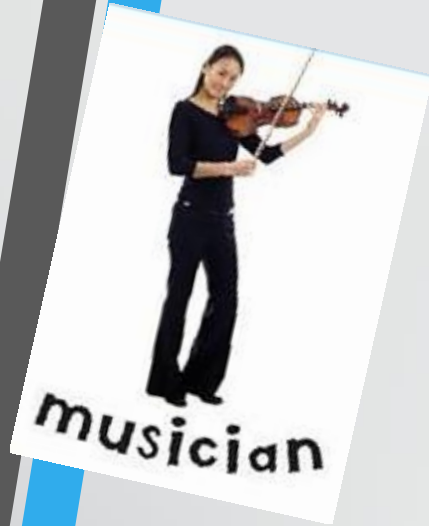

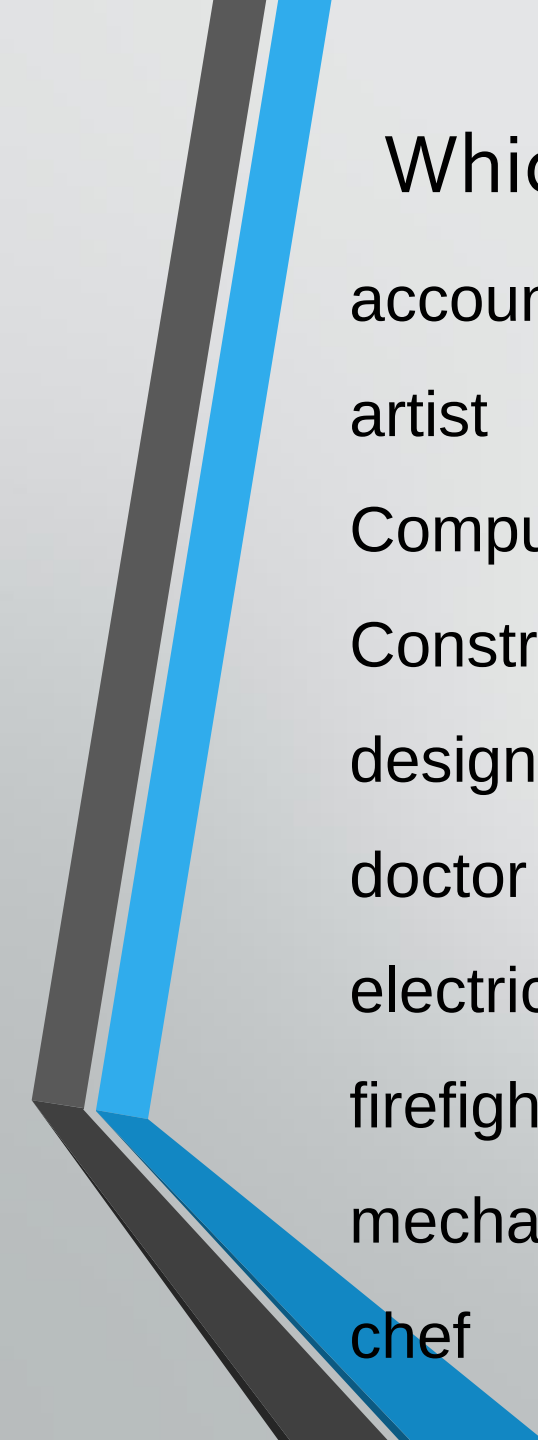

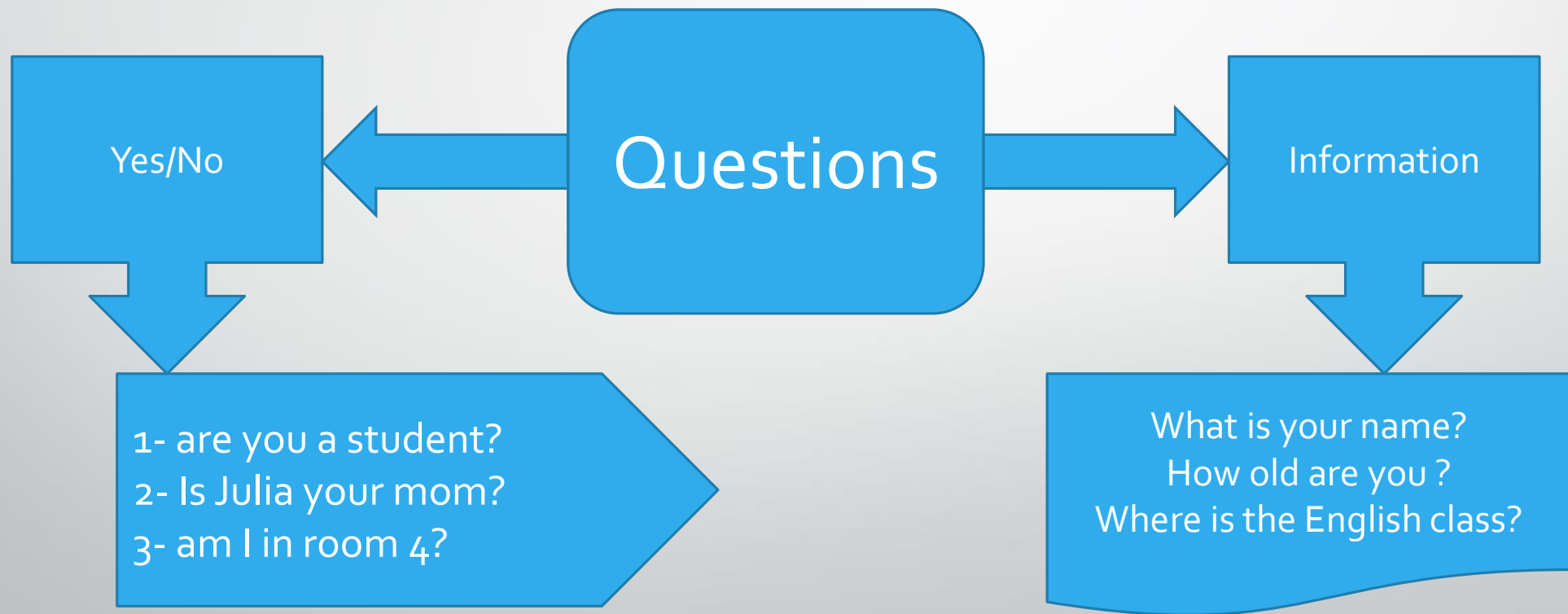

Are you Tom? Yes, I am

Is he an engineer? No, he isn't

Is she unhappy? Yes.../No...

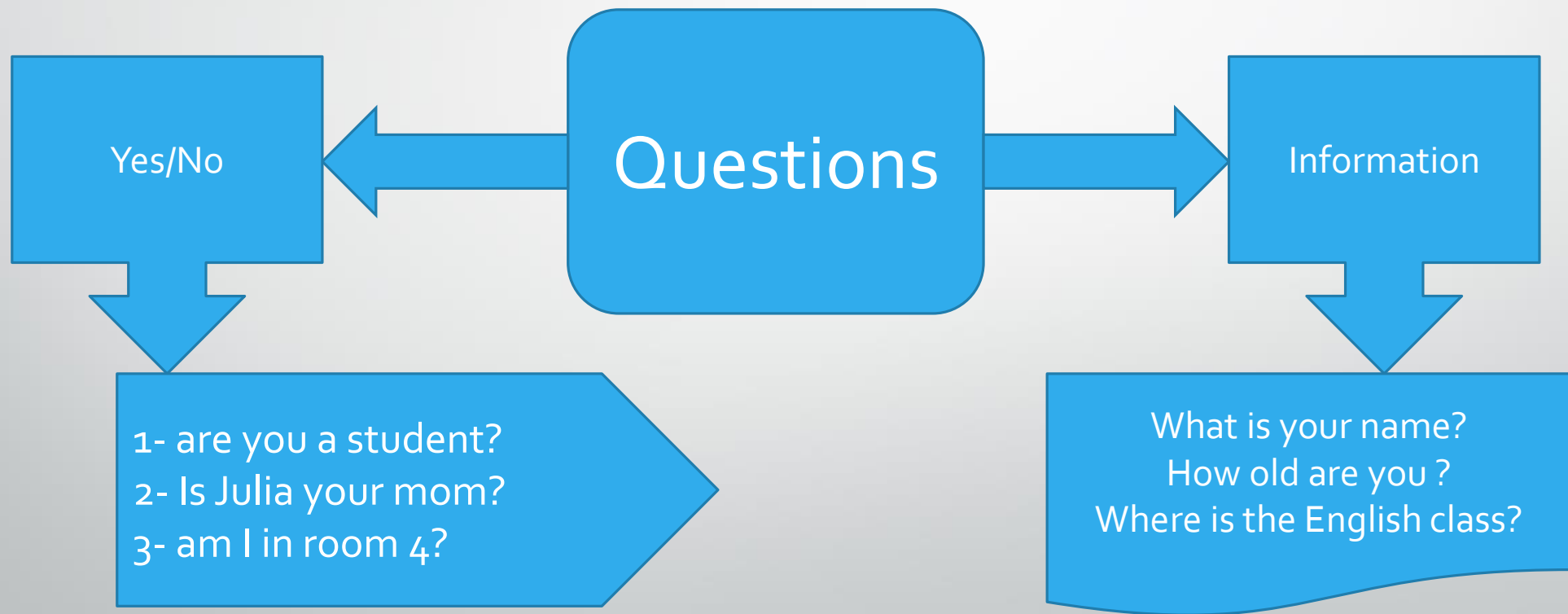
