2-Whose + nouns+ are+ these/those?

1- **whose** passport is this?

This is **Masood's** passport / This is **my** passport/This is **mine**/this passport **belongs to me**

2- **whose** passports are they?

These are **families'** passports / these are **our** passports/
these are **ours** /these passports **belong to us**
