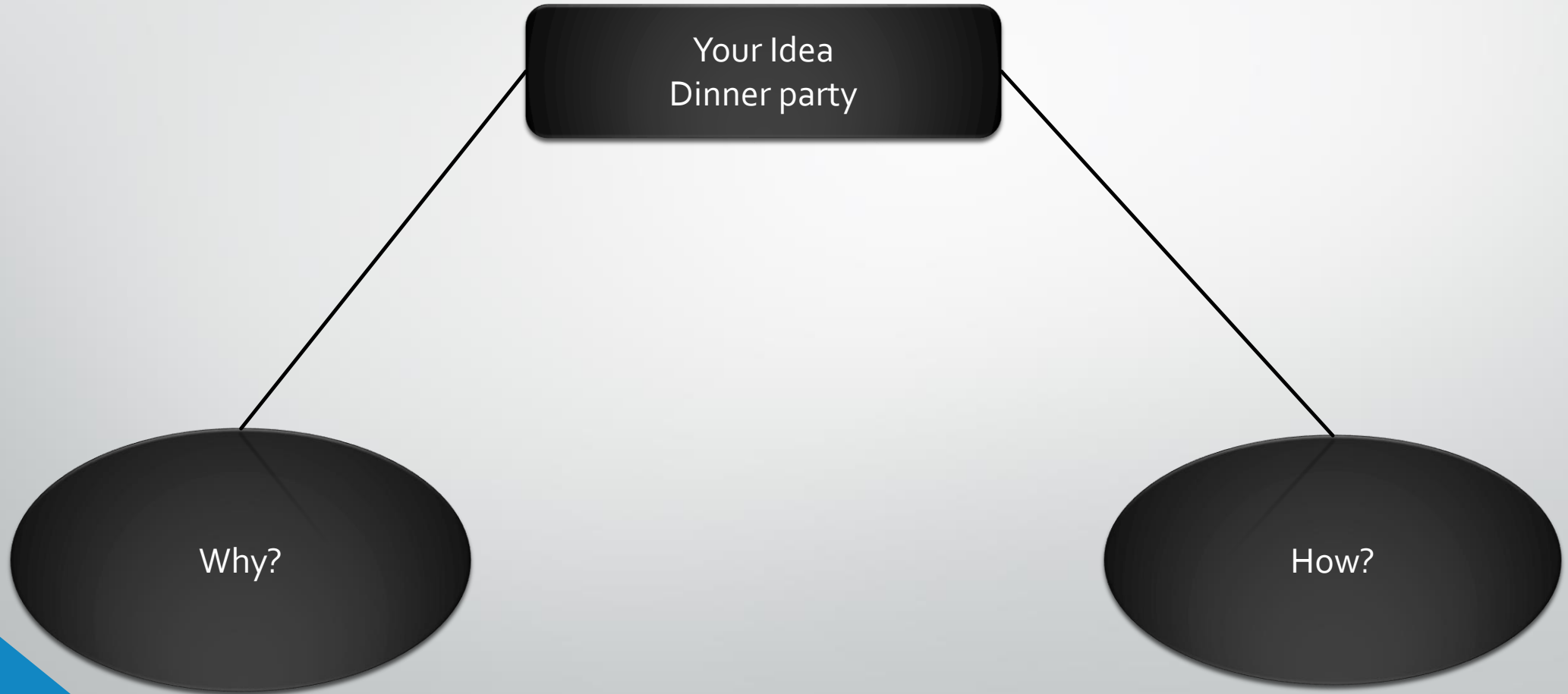

El Día de los Muertos (Day of the Dead) is a day of celebration, particularly for the people in Mexico and Central America, and for many Mexican Americans in the United States. It is a day to honour and commemorate the lives of the dearly departed and to welcome the return of their spirits.



Halloween is a holiday celebrated each year on October 31. In 2026, Halloween falls on Saturday, October 31. The tradition originated with the ancient Celtic festival of Samhain, when people would light bonfires and wear costumes to ward off ghosts.



The history of the Obon Festival dates back more than 500 years and has its roots in the Buddhist religion, specifically in a story from the Ullambana Sutra. According to this legend, a disciple of Buddha named Mokuren used supernatural powers to see the spirit of his deceased mother suffering in the world of the dead.
