Comparative adjective: compare two things/people

Adjective with one/two syllable : add -er

T-shirt is **cheaper than** shirt.
Kitchen is **bigger than** bed room.

Adjective more than two syllable :
use more or less before adjective

English language is **less difficult than**
Spanish language.
Elsa is **more beautiful than** Eva.

Irregular adjectives

much + comparative
adjective : make a
comparison stronger

Good → Better

Rob is **much better than** his brother, Tom

Bad → Worse

My grades are **worse than** yours.

superlative adjective: compare one thing/person in a group

Adjective with one/two syllable : add the...-est

T-shirt is **the cheapest** clothes.
Living room is the **biggest** room.

Adjective more than two syllable :
use the most or the least before adjective

English language is **the least difficult** language in the world.
Elsa is **the most beautiful** girl.

Irregular superlative adjectives

Good → the best
Wool is **the best** material for winter clothes.
Bad → the worst
My grades are **the worst** In the class.

Adjective order

Opinion	Size	Age	Color	Nationality	Material	Object
Comfortable	Large	New	Black	Italian	Cotton	Sweater

Use comma between
adjectives

It's a comfortable, large, Italian sweater.
It's a new, black, cotton sweater.
