- **blood** (U) It is pronounced like *sun*

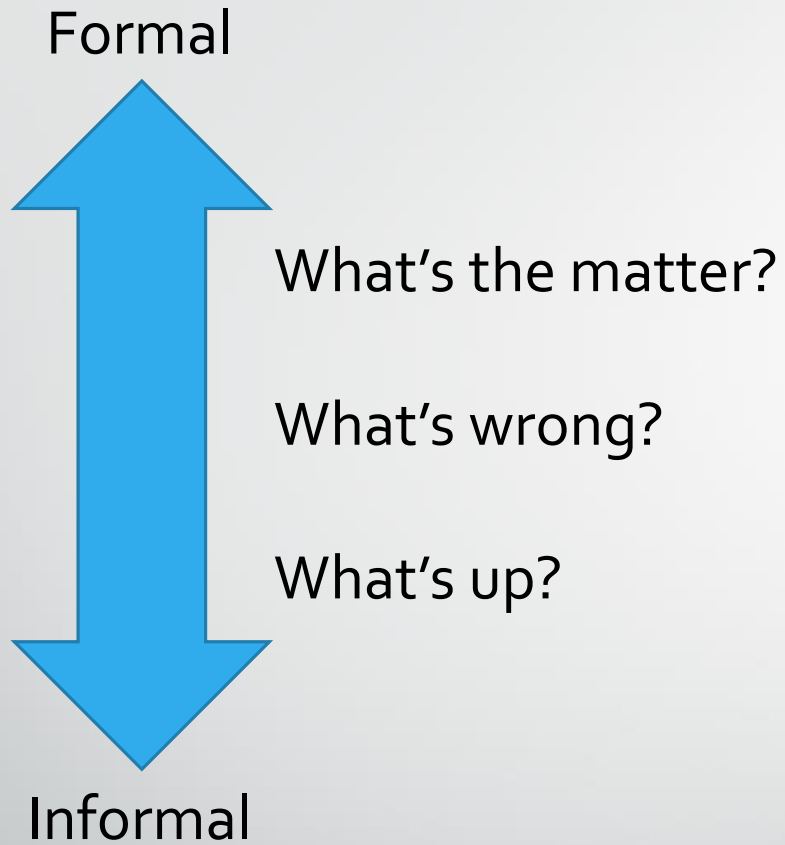
Feel, look + adjectives

Does Tom look tired?	How is she feeling? She feels OK

(?) Should I see a doctor? Yes, you should / No, you shouldn't

(?) What should I do?

Should is a modal verb, it means need another verb to complete the meaning the sentence.

After SHOULD verb is base form.

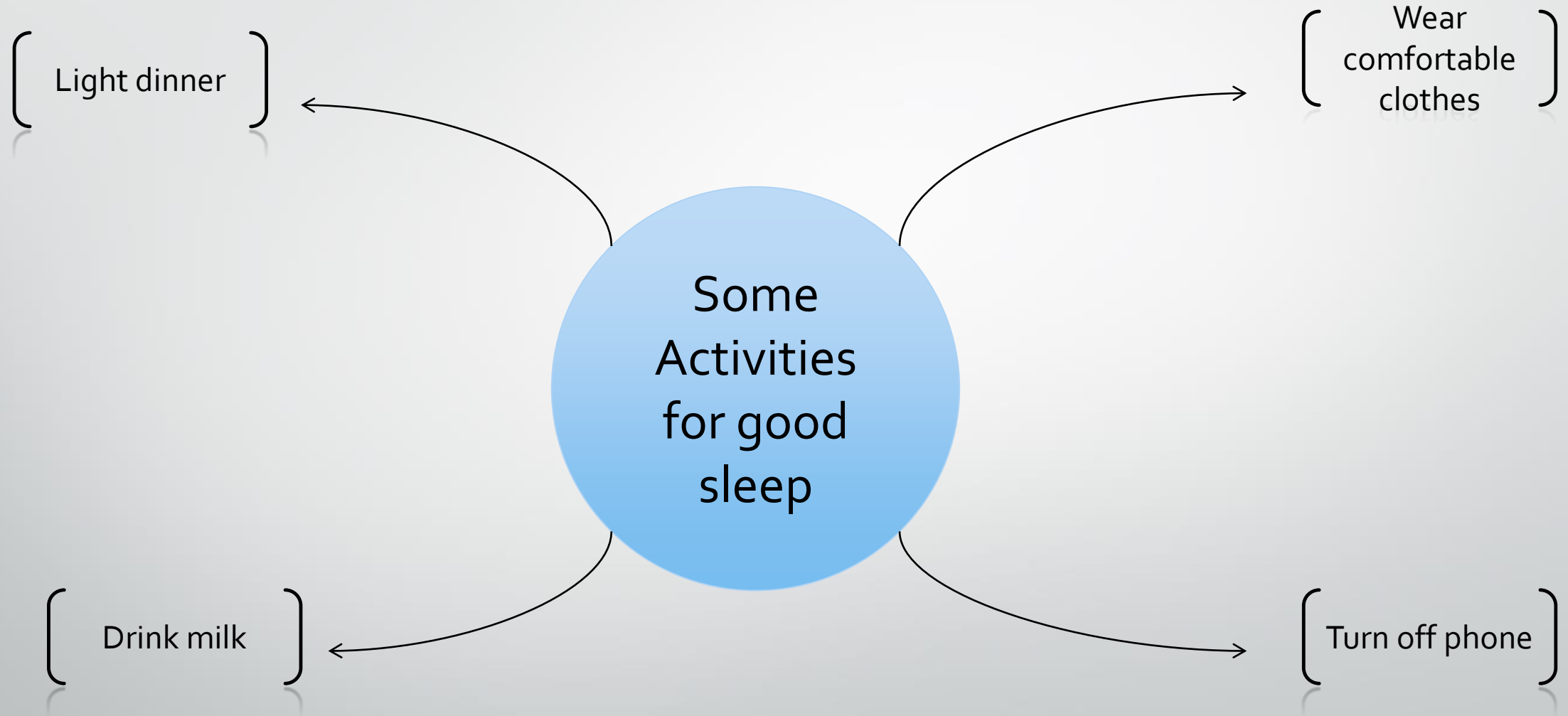
