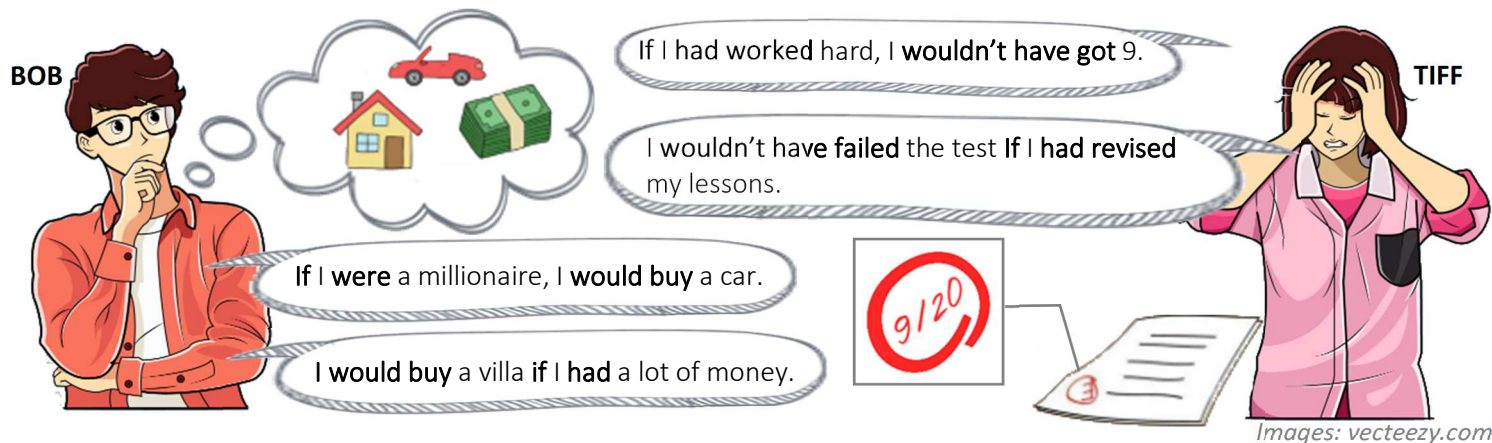


ACTIVITY 1

- If Bob had a lot of money, he would buy a villa. (He doesn't own a villa at the present time)
- If Tiff had worked hard, she would have passed 6. (She didn't work hard in the past)
- If Tiff had revised her lessons, she would have passed 6. (She didn't revise in the past)

ACTIVITY 3

STUDY AND COMPLETE THE RULES ABOUT SECOND AND THIRD CONDITIONALS.

PRESENT [conditional 2]

- If I were a millionaire, I would buy a car.
- I would buy a villa if I had a lot of money.

► If + S + simple past,
S + modal + simple verb

PAST [conditional 3]

- If I had worked hard, I wouldn't have got 6.
- I wouldn't have failed the test if I had revised my lessons.

► If + S + past perfect,
S + modal + had + p.p.

► We can use "could / might" in some context.

► We always change the meaning from the positive sense into the negative, or from the negative into the positive.

If he had been very careful, he wouldn't have fallen downstairs.



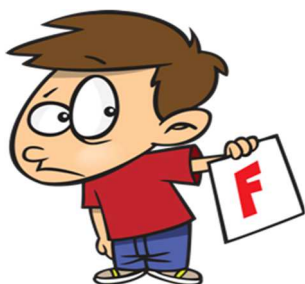
2. Peter can't go to school because he is very sick.

If Peter weren't very sick, he could go to school.



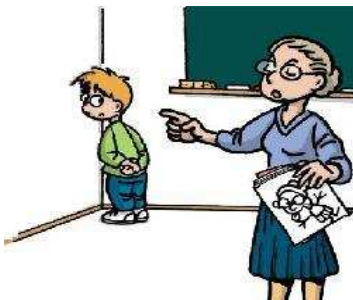
3. As he came late to work last week, the boss fired him.

If Jack had done his homework, the teacher wouldn't have punished him.



6. She can't win the race because she doesn't run fast.

If she ran fast, she could win the race
