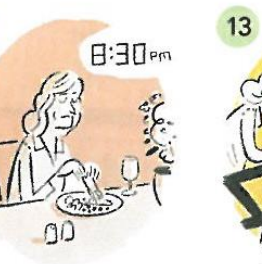

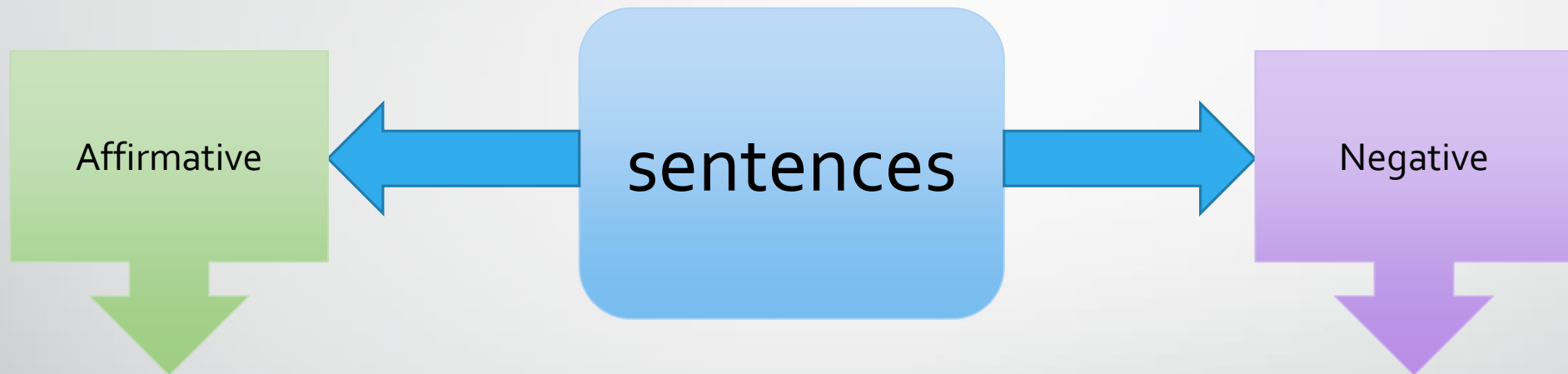

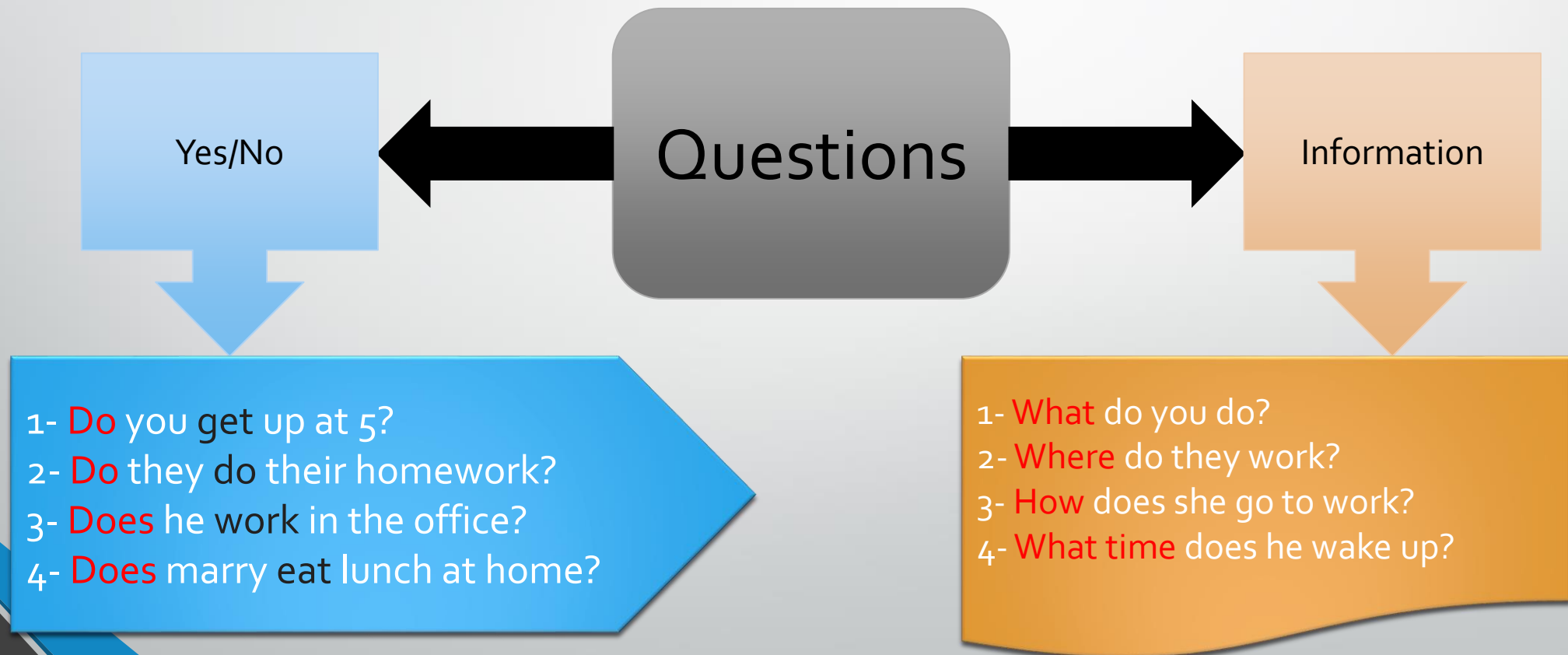
How to make Negative sentences

Subject pronouns + don't + Verb (base form)+...

(Third person) Subject pronouns + doesn't + Verb (base form)+...

- (-) I **don't** study English language.
- (-) Tom and Rob **don't** study English language.
- (-) She **doesn't** **study** English language
- (-) Sara **doesn't** **study** English language

How to make questions...



How to make YES/NO questions

Do/Does + **Subject pronouns** + Verb (base form) + ...

Do **they** do their homework? Yes, they do

Does **he** work in the office? No, he doesn't

How to make Information questions

Wh-word + **Do/Does** + **Subject pronouns** + **Verb(base form)** + ..

What **do** **you** **do**?

I'm a teacher. I work in an office

where **does** **she** **go**?

She **goes** to class.

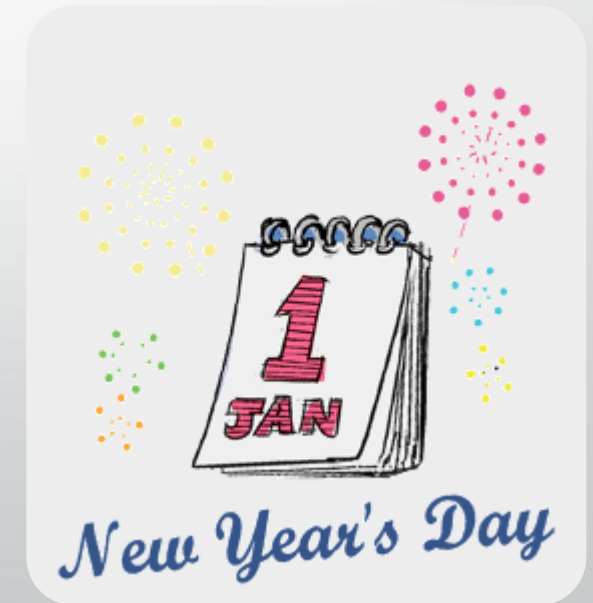

100%) Always

- I **always** study English

How to make questions with adverbs of frequency

1- Do you **usually** have dinner with your family?

Yes , I **always** have dinner with my family.

2- Where do you **usually** eat breakfast?

I **often** eat breakfast at work.

How often does she drink coffee?

She sometimes drinks coffee the bus
