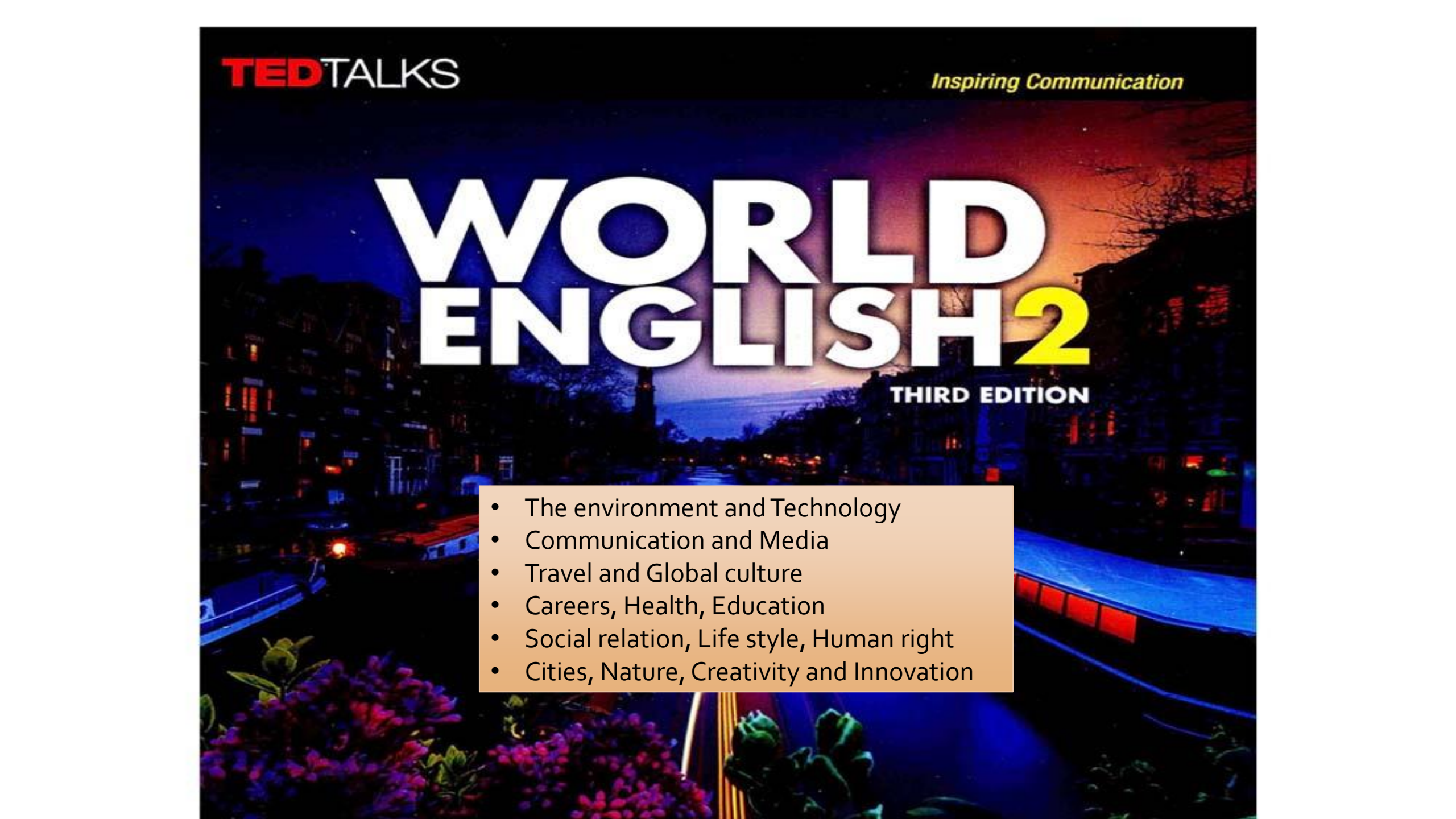

She studies English every day

TV doesn't work.

Does Anna have break fast every morning?

Present continuous

She is studying English now.

you 're not listening to me.

Are you doing your homework right now?

Regional food

*In my region, people eat a lot of rice and vegetables.
A popular food is kebab.*

What food is popular in your city or region?



Sentence starters:

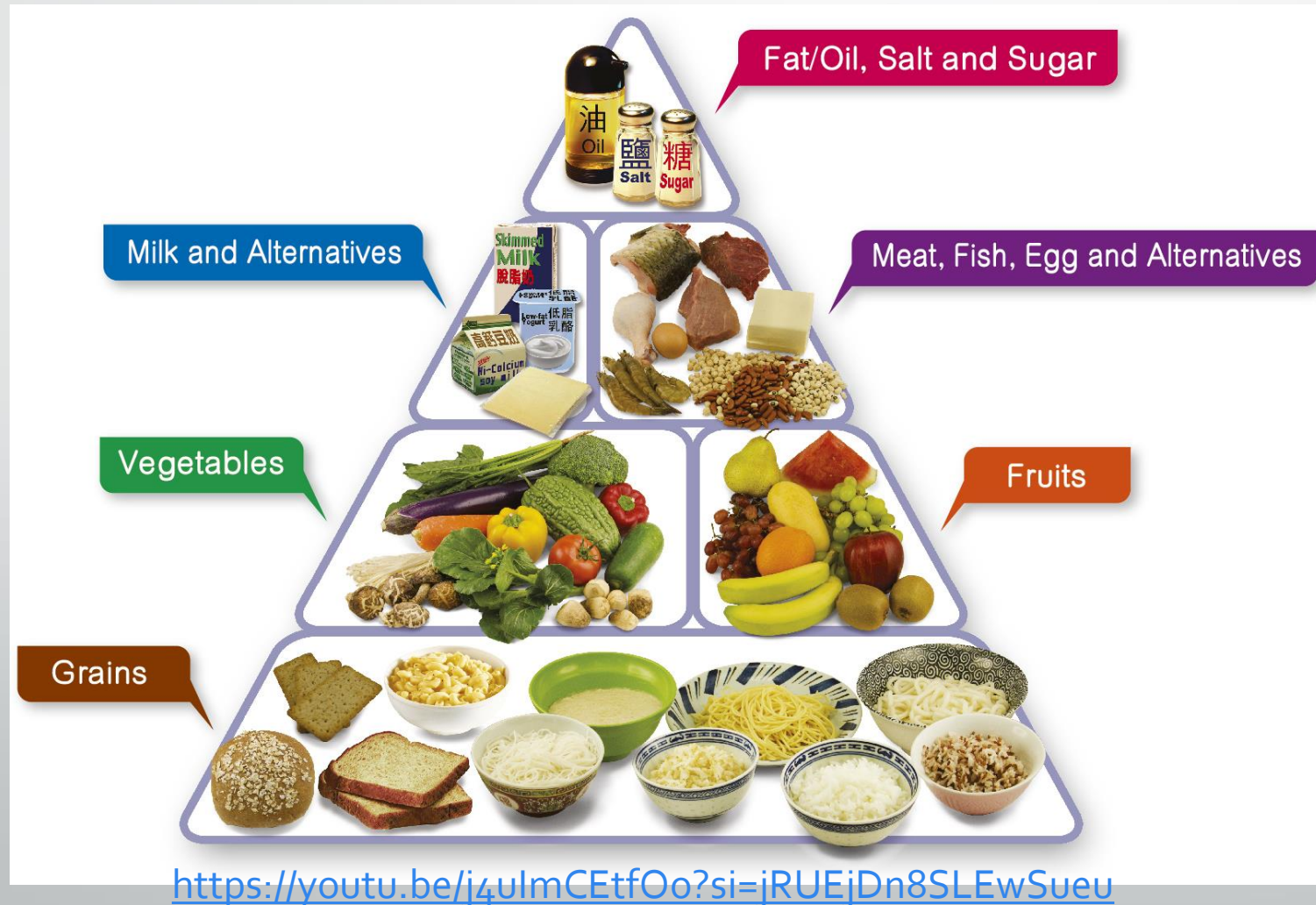
*In my region, people eat...
This food has... (rice / meat / vegetables)
People eat it for breakfast / lunch / dinner.
It is healthy / spicy / cheap.*

Opinion:

*I like it because...
It is good for health / not very healthy*

Simple past with regular verbs

I moved to another city 2 years before.

She didn't study for exam last night.

Did Tom travel to Iran 2 months ago?

Simple past with irregular verbs

I was in the class last session.

He didn't come to part yesterday.

Did you go to grandma's house last weekend?

Was/were : past form of BE

Main Idea

☞ The **main idea** is the **most important point** the writer wants to say.

- One sentence
- General
- Answers: “What is this paragraph about?”

Supporting Details

☞ **Supporting details** give **specific information** about the main idea.

- Several sentences
- Specific facts, examples, reasons
- Answer: “How?” “Why?” “In what way?”
