Plural:

These+ are+ noun(plural)

Ex: **these** are pens

These are erasers

Singular:

That +Is+ a/an+ noun

Ex: **That** is a pen

That is an eraser

Plural:

Those+ are+ noun(plural)

Ex: **Those** are pens

Those are erasers

(+) This is **a** class.
(-) That isn't **a** your pencil.
(?) Is this **an** eraser?
Yes, It is/ No, It isn't

(+) these **are** books in the bookcase.
(-) those **aren't** my pens.
(?) Are these your note books?
Yes, they are / No, they aren't
